







Parents Online Payments

Parents & Carers can now make online payments to KPS!

Payments can be made via computer, tablet or mobile phone using either a Debit, Visa or Mastercard and will be processed via a secure payment page hosted by Westpac.

The payment page is accessed from the front page of the KPS website by selecting <u>\$ Make a payment</u>, or you can be accessed via our SchoolStream app.

Items that can be paid include voluntary school contributions, excursions and sales to students. There is also a category called 'Other' this covers items not covered in the previous headings.

When you access the <u>\$ Make a payment</u> you must enter:

-the students name

-class

-date of birth

-item name/reference/reason for payment

These details are entered each time you make a payment as student information is not held within the payment system. There is also the option to enter the Student Registration Number and Invoice number (these are not used at our school) please leave blank.

This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner, these details are not passed back to the school.

Under payment options, you enter the activity or item for which you are paying. Write a title in the Payment Description that will enable the School Staff to match your payment with the school activity or item. You have the ability to check and change any details of the payment before the payment is pro-

cessed. Receipts can be emailed and/or printed. Because a receipt has been issued from the website a further receipt will not be issued by the school. Furthermore, payments for each child need to be made separately; To make payments for another

sibling/s you do this at the Online Payment Receipt stage, at the bottom of the page click the tab 'make another payment' and proceed to fill in details.

If payments are made before 6pm, details of the payments are passed to the school the next morning and will be matched against your child's account. If payments are made after 6pm the school cannot access them until 2 days later. Again, as a receipt has been issued from the website a further receipt will not be issued by the school.

- How to get the School Stream app on your mobile device
- 1. From your mobile device go to the App Store (iPhone/iPad) or Play Store (Android), search for School Stream and download the app to your phone.
- 2 Make sure you agree to push notifications
- 3. Once School Stream has finished installing, open the app, type your school name into the search then select your school. For more detailed instructions go to schoolstream.com.au/download
- 4 Are your children attending different schools? Tap the school selector, 🚛 select add a school, type the school name' into the search then add. Jump between your children's schools by touching the school name/logo in the top blue bar, or switch schools from the slide-in menu. *Any additional schools will need to be licensed users of School Stream to appear in the app.

Choose what notifications you receive

- ٦. Open the School Stream app on your mobile device
- 2 From the slide-in menu, go to Settings 3.
 - Under Edit/Alerts select My Schools and select your School to open the Notifications page
- Toggle notifications on or off individually (e.g. Alerts, Events, Newsletters, etc.) 4
- 5. When you have finished, use the Back button to return to the Settings page, then select Done to return to your School
