Congratulations to Jack Branda and Jayden Ward of Kelso Public School who competed as a part of the Western team in the NSW PSSA Opens Rugby League carnival, held June 26-28 at Glen Willow Stadium in Mudgee. The carnival included 13 Regional teams from all of NSW including Public, Catholic and Independent School systems. The Western team lead by coach Mr Ben Smith of Parkes Public School, acquitted themselves tremendously well over the 3 days, growing in confidence and cohesion each game, impressing coaches, parents and spectators with their steely defence, determination and commitment to their teammates.


